[1] 次の英文をよく読み、それに続く設問に答えなさい。

We are suffering from COVID-19. COVID-19 means coronavirus disease. It has spread all over the world and has changed our lives in many ways. Japanese government asked people to stay away from crowds and wear masks. In some countries, people couldn't go out even if it was necessary. A lot of companies asked their workers to work from home. All of the workers used their computers to work from home. It is called "remote work."

Drug companies tried to develop *vaccines (\mathcal{T}). It usually [A] a long time to develop a new vaccine, but some vaccines were developed by the end of 2020. Japan's *vaccination program began in February 2021.

Because of the coronavirus, handwashing with soap has become very important. Everyone needs to wash their hands many times [B] day, but do you think it is fun? (1) Maybe not. In 2019, many famous people started to sing songs about handwashing. For example, PIKOTARO sang the song, "PPAP-2020-PIKOWash! ver." You can watch it on YouTube. Now many children wash their hands. You can also enjoy (2) [sing] the song and (3) [wash] your hands.

We know that handwashing is important, but (4) (\mathcal{T} . easy for / 1. to / 2. is not / 1. it / 2. some people / 2. around the world) wash their hands. Do you know why? One of the workers of *UNICEF said,

(5) "Handwashing with soap is one of the cheapest and most effective ways that you can prevent coronavirus." When you wash your hands for 15 seconds with *running water, 99% of viruses will disappear. When you wash your hands with soap, only 0.01% of viruses will remain. So, we can protect ourselves. Also, we can protect many people who cannot (6) do this.

There are some problems that we should know about. There are around 8 billion people in the world. About 40 percent of the world's people can't wash their hands with clean water or soap at home. Also, about 50 percent of schools don't have a place for handwashing. About 15 percent of healthcare centers even don't have handwashing places. Many people in developing countries such as South Africa can't wash their hands, so they are getting sick. As you know, in developing countries, it's very important to wash hands. Developing countries need help from developed countries. Japan and other countries should give some help. What can we do to help everyone around the world?
